The TENCompetence project was funded by the European Commission to establish a technical and organisational infrastructure for lifelong competence development in Europe.

The principal product of the project is the Personal Competence Manager, which provides a system for organisations, groups and individual users which is:

- Open Source
- Service oriented
- Standards compliant

The TENCompetence Foundation has been established to ensure the results of the TENCompetence project are sustained after the end of the project. The TENCompetence Foundation will:

- Provide ownership of the code base and manage the release schedule
- Facilitate and provide leadership to the TENCompetence developers network
- Facilitate the TENCompetence user network
- Further develop the TENCompetence vision to guide future work
